

Specific Privacy Statement for DPO - DRMKC Website

1. Description

The Disaster Risk Management Knowledge Centre website (DRMKC) process personal data about stakeholders and partners co-operating in a scientific research networks.

This processing is managed at the Joint Research Centre (JRC) by the DG JRC E.1 Disaster Risk Management Unit / Space, Security and Migration Directorate in relation with the 7th Research Framework Programme (FP7) for the purpose mentioned under point 2.

As this processing collects and further processes personal data, Regulation (EC) 45/2001, of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 December 2000 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data by the Community institutions and bodies and on the free movement of such data, is applicable.

This processing of personnel data is under the responsibility of the Head of Unit Internal and external communication at the JRC.

The Head of unit "Disaster Risk Management E.1" who manages the processing itself acts as personal data processor.

2. What personal information do we collect, for what purpose and through which technical means?

Identification Data

The following information is required to be a registered DRMKC user:

- First name
- Last name
- E-mail
- Organisation
- Country

Purpose

Personal data are collected and processed in order to communicate with the data subjects about the JRC research activities related to the 7th Research Framework Programme (FP7).

Technical information

Personal data are normally collected through classical databases or Excel forms and stored on JRC servers.

3. Who has access to your information and to whom is it disclosed?

Access to the personal data is allowed to authorized officials and other staff of the JRC. No personal data is transmitted to parties, which are outside the recipients and the legal framework mentioned.

In some specific cases, personal contact data could be published on a publicly available website of the JRC. An additional opt-in/opt-out option is proposed to confirm acceptance to such publication.

4. How do we protect and safeguard your information?

The collected personal data is stored on the servers of JRC and underlie the Commission Decision C (2006) 3602 of 17/08/2006 "concerning the security of information systems used by the European Commission" defines IT security measures in force. Annex I defines the security requirements of EC Information Systems. Annex II defines the different actors and their responsibilities. Annex III defines the rules applicable by users.

5. How can you verify, modify or delete your information?

Upon a justified request submitted to the above mentioned functional mailbox, your data will be rectified, modified, frozen or eventually erased in a maximum period of 10 working days.

6. How long do we keep your data?

Your personal data is kept as long as follow-up actions linked to the above mentioned purpose are necessary. All personal data will be deleted at the end of the 7th Research Framework Programme (FP7).
