The GCRI is part of the DRMKC, which was launched in 2015 to answer the emerging need for evidence-based decision-making in Disaster Risk Management and to meet the requirements of European and global agendas for Disaster Risk Reduction and Climate Change Adaptation.





GCRI: Modelling the risk of conflicts at global scale

The GCRI serves as quantitative input into the Conflict Early Warning System (EWS) of the European External **Action Service.** The EWS identifies top priority countries for conflict prevention around the world, which then become the focus of preventive or peacebuilding actions over the next 4 years.

- 22 open-source structural variables in 6 risk dimensions
- Yearly output
- Statistical models to calculate probability and intensity of violent conflict over the next 1-4 years

Dynamic conflict risk model: Africa

Scope: detect early warning signs of conflict at sub-national level on a shorter time scale.

- Pilot model for subnational regions Africa (Admin-1 level)
- Focus on climate-related conflict drivers and other dynamic variables
- Monthly risk assessment for the next 1-6 months

Science4Peace portal
